



Radiology Indicator Color Scheme Changes

WHAT: The color scheme of the Radiology indicators will be changing to better signify the status of an exam.

- WHY:**
- Create better visual flow of radiology exam statuses on the ED tracker
 - Improve communication between Radiology and the Emergency Department.

WHEN: Anticipated go live date: Thursday, February 26, 2015

DETAILS:

The biggest change is **TKN** will now be **LIGHT GREEN** as opposed to **YELLOW**.

- This will let the physicians and staff know the exam has been taken but not yet resulted.
- At this status the exam is viewable in PACS but has not been read by the Radiologist
