New Transcription Vendor

St. Joseph Health is transitioning all ministries to one transcription vendor. St. Jude will transition March 28.

- Your dictation number and the hospital's dictation number (ext. 3090 or (714) 992-3090 will not change.
- Dictation prompts and work types will change. You will now need to enter the Facility Code 101. Dictation cards and more information are being sent to all providers.

The new voice recognition transcription service will allow most transcribed reports to populate directly to the EMR (not including operative reports and discharge summaries). The change will make it easier for IT to troubleshoot issues related to interfaces, phones, format or MEDITECH, as well as, provide cost savings.
