

MEDITECH Standardization: Physician Update



April 29, 2014

MEDITECH standardization will be implemented on Sunday, June 1 at 10 a.m.

The standardization efforts involve moving all SJH ministries to a standardized version of the MEDITECH 5.66 system. Ultimately, standardizing systems across our network will allow us to have one platform and share information.

However, this will be a challenging transition and will require some changes in the way you work. The best way to prepare for the implementation on June 1 is to complete physician training – it's your chance to experience the new system and workflows prior to go-live.

Please follow the instructions below to complete the MEDITECH standardization eLearning modules.

Steps to Take:

April 21 - May 31: Healthstream open for eLearning modules (see sidebar). **This is required.**

April 23 - May 31: Proctor Lab open to assist with eLearning modules and pin resets. Located on 4 main (TCC), Room 482, Mon.- Fri., 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.

April 23 - May 31: Pin reset – required to access MEDITECH. Must complete eLearning module first.

Option 1: Attend Proctor Lab. This requires advance registration in Healthstream.

Option 2: Pin reset by phone. Please call the physician liaisons at: (714) 446-5162 or (714) 446-5151.

April 29: Pin reset at General Staff Meeting from 6 - 8 p.m. Reminder: eLearning modules must be completed prior to pin reset.

May 16-31: Favorite order sets by appointment with physician liaisons: Melanie Rubio (714) 446-5162 and Greg Mercado at (714) 446-5151.

May 31: Deadline to complete training and pin reset. Suspension begins.

June 1: GO LIVE!
